Ben qualified as an OT in Australia in 1998 and has worked in all areas of the rehabilitation process: intensive care, inpatient, outpatient, transitional living, community, vocational and case management. He has worked in the public and private sectors in Australia and the UK. Ben specialises in working with adults with traumatic brain injury but also has experience with other conditions including amputations, spinal cord injury and complex orthopaedic.

He started his career on a brain injury rehabilitation unit in Sydney in 1999, later working as a case manager in Sydney in 2002. He also regularly completed expert witness work in Australia and provided expert testimony in the Supreme Court of New South Wales.

In the UK, Ben worked at management level on an NHS inpatient neurological rehabilitation centre of excellence in London, supervising several professional staff and assistants. Following this, he worked with a private brain injury case management company in Suffolk.

Ben also has skills in motivational interviewing, recruitment, training and supervision of professionals and support workers, cognitive assessment and intervention, upper limb and neurological/physical rehabilitation, splinting, home adaptations and wheelchair prescriptions.

Since starting the company in 2009, he has maintained a caseload of catastrophic cases, in addition to the role of clinical and managing director of the company. Ben has provided professional services internationally in Australia, Northern Ireland, Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, Greece, Poland and the Czech Republic.
