Since qualifying as an Occupational Therapist in 1995 Lisa has gained a wealth of experience in clinical and senior managerial roles both in the NHS and Private Health Care settings.

During her clinical career she managed a clinical caseload of more complex cases such as Acquired Brain Injury, Spinal Injury, Parkinsons Disease, Multiple Sclerosis and burns and plastics.

She provided assessment, rehabilitation and complex discharge planning to those aiming to return home from their inpatient stay. Clinical areas in which Lisa worked were varied and included acute psychiatry, acquired brain injury, spinal injury, neurology, orthopedic rehabilitation, general medicine, burns, general surgery and palliative care.

She provided senior clinical support and supervision at the stroke unit - Finchley Memorial Hospital, London and rehabilitation clinical support at Potters Bar Community Hospital.
