She has developed a special interest in clients with prolonged disorders of consciousness, advocating ongoing assessment and rehabilitation for those who may make slower progress. She is adept at leading multidisciplinary teams in goal focused treatment ensuring that interventions are timed appropriately and monitored closely to ensure effectiveness. She has experience of managing clients with a range of disability, including supporting and maintaining independent living in the community and vocational rehabilitation.

Kat is also experienced in treating clients with vestibular disorders. She saw outpatients at the Royal Free Hospital referred from Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital (RNTNE), from 2005 to 2008, and led the service/completed training for junior staff from 2006-2008.
