Skills & Experience Summary

Hannah qualified as a Registered General Nurse (RGN) in 2002 and followed her long-held ambition to work in the community setting. In her initial role, she was the first newly qualified community nurse in the Primary Care Trust (PCT). In this emerging role, she researched nutrition and wound healing and was approached by the PCT to introduce a nutritional screening tool. This led her towards a new position of Nutrition Nurse Advisor for an enteral feeding company involving teaching, training and provision of a telephone advice service. She worked within a large multi-disciplinary team providing support for the client, their relatives and carers.

After a brief time travelling and working in Australia, Hannah took a role as a Practice Nurse. She completed an MSc in Advanced Healthcare Practice and gained the qualification to work as an Advanced Nurse Practitioner, which involves assessment, diagnosis and treating clients. This course also enabled her to become an independent and supplementary non-medical prescriber. She has continued to work within this area since qualifying in 2012. This role requires excellent history taking skills, assessing the needs of the patient, care planning, diagnosing and treating. She has gained extensive experience in completing whole body assessments and has a keen interest in neurological and musculoskeletal assessments, minor injuries and polytrauma.

In 2015 she acquired a role as Nurse Lecturer and completed a PgCE in Healthcare Education and became a Fellow of the Higher Education Academy (FHEA). She lectured in pre and post registration nursing and focused on adults with a diverse range of health and dependency needs, including physical, social and emotional care requirements.

Hannah completed a course in clinical and academic hypnosis in 2019 and currently provides hypnosis and hypnotherapy to people living with trauma, stress, pain, sleep disturbance and anxiety.



Hannah joined BHL in early 2020 and provides case management to adults who have sustained polytrauma and brain injury.
