Since qualifying as an Occupational Therapist at University of East Anglia in 2009, Ellie has gained considerable experience in the field of neuro Case Management and Occupational Therapy. She has worked in both the charity and private sector and as a result has experience in supporting clients and services with varying financial backgrounds, in accessing professional support, therapy, activity, equipment and housing for example.

For the past 10 years Ellie has worked as a case manager and occupational therapist, for individuals with brain injury including cerebral palsy, spinal injury, and polytrauma, with varying levels of function from adults in minimally conscious states requiring high levels of support and care, through to those living independently and in paid employment with light touch support. As such, she has a wealth of experience in working with other services including education, employers, and statutory services, striving to work collaboratively with them to promote excellent communication, and maximise opportunity for quality outcomes for the client.

Ellie works with clients and their families both pre- and post-settlement of medical negligence or personal injury awards and is experienced in report writing both in

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producing immediate needs assessments and regular progress reports on her clients.
